BEFORE SCHOOL SCHEDULE

6:30 – 7:15	Jrs/Srs	<u>Welcome & Self-selected activities</u> : table games, puzzles, reading center, construction, creative arts, etc.
6:45 – 8:30	Jrs/Srs	<u>Snack bar</u> open and available.
7:15-7:45	Jrs/Srs	<u>Morning Activity Stations Open</u> : Reading area, Soft area, Construction, Games, Higher Level, Science, Creative Expression, Art, Homework Help and learning activities with <i>STEM daily</i>
7:45- 8:00	Jrs/Srs	<u>Team Time</u>
8:00-8:30	Jrs/Srs	<u>Outside/Gym Time</u> - organized games
8:30- 8:45	Jrs/Srs	<u>Prepare for a day of learning</u> : final bathroom break and clean up. Dismissal
8:45-9:00		Staff finish clean up

AFTER SCHOOL SCHEDULE

3:45-3:50	Jrs/Srs	<u>Arrival</u> : the staff warmly greets Children.
3:50 – 4:05	Jrs/Srs	<u>Self-selected activities</u> : table games, puzzles, reading center, construction, creative arts, etc.
4:05 – 4:15	Jrs/Srs	<u>Team Time</u> : The group will meet to discuss upcoming events and/or fundraisers, assist in planning activities, meet with club representatives on designated days, team building activities, brain teasers or do enrichment activities such as <i>STEM (daily)</i> , art history, science, math, literature, social studies, etc.
4:15-4:45	Jrs/Srs	<u>Homework/Quiet Choice Activities</u> : Children can begin their homework or choose to read quietly use their higher level thinking activity center, creative arts activity center, play a table game and long term craft projects.
4:15–5:00	Jrs/Srs	<u>Snack bar</u> open and available
4:45-5:15	Jrs/Srs	<u>Outside/Gym Games</u> : Large muscle activities such as baseball, soccer, kick ball, team building games, jump rope, relay races, etc.
5:15-5:45	Jrs/Srs	<u>Afternoon Activity Stations Open</u> : Reading area, Soft area, Construction, Games, Higher Level, Science, Creative Expression, Art, Homework Help and learning activities with <i>STEM daily</i>
5:45-6:00	Jrs/Srs	<u>Self-Selected Activities</u> : Table games, reading center, construction, creative arts, puzzles, etc. At this time children can take part in the Special Projects Activity center, which focuses on enrichment areas of cooking, drama, math, science, social studies, literature and woodworking.
6:15 – 6:30	Jrs/Srs	<u>Clean Up</u> : Children and staff at various times are assigned to specific jobs and assist in the cleanup of the center.

PROGRAM ORIENTATION

Parent orientations are held at each center in September/October and again in May for new registrants by the Center Director. A tour of the center is given, the daily schedule reviewed, and any questions will be addressed. Families enrolling other months of the year may schedule an individual orientation with the Director.

SNACKS

Snack bars are available to the children both in the morning and afternoon programs. A minimum of two food groups are provided for the children along with milk or fruit juice and water each AM and PM session. The snack bars are available to the children for approximately 30 minutes in the mornings and an hour and a half in the afternoons. Snack menus are posted on our Parent Bulletin Boards.
