Were you aware that each ABC Care center has a “**team incentive plan**” that encourages and rewards your children’s positive social interactions and behaviors? Our ABC Care Staff receive numerous trainings on behavior plans for both large groups and individuals. We use incentive programs and also individual “**peace**” or “**cool down**” boxes that teach children to demonstrate a wide variety of their emotions in appropriate ways. We also utilize ABC Care created “**Problem Solving Reports**” to guide children in learning how to resolve social and emotional conflicts.

When you see an **ABC Care Problem Solver Report** or **Conflict Resolution Sheet** please do not view it only in a negative light. They are

excellent learning opportunities for your children to practice both problem solving and conflict resolution skills to enable them to **become**

happy, successful adults! We have found that **success with children’s development occurs when home, school, and child care are**

all sharing clear communications and working together on common goals; the safety and well being of your child.
