### BEFORE SCHOOL SCHEDULE

6:30-7:45	Morning Fun Club	<u>Self selected activities:</u> table games, puzzles, reading center, construction, creative arts, etc.
6:30-8:00	Morning Fun Club	<u>Snack bar</u> open and available.
7:45-8:00	Morning Fun Club	<u>Team Time:</u> The group will meet to discuss upcoming events and/or fundraisers, plan activities, storytelling, brain teasers, or do enrichment activities such as science, art history, math, social studies etc.
8:00-8:30	Morning Fun Club	Gym Time, Freechoice
8:30-8:45	Morning Fun Club	<u>Prepare for a day of learning:</u> final bathroom break and clean up. Dismissal: staff escort children to class.

### AFTER SCHOOL SCHEDULE

3:45-3:50	All (grade 3-5)	<u>Arrival:</u> Children are warmly greeted by the staff and place their belongings in their personal tote.
3:50-3:55	All (grade 3-5))	<u>Bathroom and Water Break/Sign Language</u>
3:55-4:10	All (grade 3-5))	<u>Team Time:</u> The group will meet to discuss upcoming events and/or fundraisers, assist in planning activities, meet with club representatives on designated days, team building activities, brain teasers or do enrichment activities such as science, art history, math, literature, social studies, etc.
4:10-4:40	All (grade 3-5)	<u>Outside/Gym Games:</u> Large muscle activities such as baseball, soccer, kick ball, team building games, jump rope, relay races, that are age appropriate.
4:40	All (grade 3-5))	Snack open and available
4:40-5:00	All (grade 3-5))	<u>Snack/Homework/Reading/Higher Level Thinking:</u> Children can begin their homework or choose to read quietly, use the higher level thinking activity center, creative arts activity center or play a table game.
5:00-5:45	All (grade 3-5))	<u>Arts &amp; Crafts and Special/Creative Expressions/Games/Construction:</u> Children have the opportunity to utilize their imaginations to create paintings, murals, long-term craft projects; such as doll houses, model cars, clay dinosaurs, and learn artistic techniques and styles of other cultures, while table games, reading center, construction area are all available to children.
5:45-6:00	All (grade 3-5)	<u>Clean Up:</u> Children and staff at various times are assigned to specific jobs and assist in the cleanup of the center.
6:00-6:15	All (grade 3-5)	Gym Time/Free Choice
6:15-6:30	All (grade 3-5)	Clean-up; Center closes



## **PROGRAM ORIENTATION**

Parent orientations are held at each center in September/October and again in May for new registrants by the Center Director. A tour of the center is given, the daily schedule reviewed and any questions will be addressed. Families enrolling other months of the year may schedule an individual orientation with the Director.

## **SNACKS**

Snack bars are available to the children both in the morning and afternoon programs. A minimum of two food groups are provided for the children along with milk or fruit juice and water each AM and PM session. The snack bars are available to the children for approximately 30 minutes in the mornings and an hour and a half in the afternoons. Snack menus are posted on our Parent Bulletin Boards.
