BEFORE SCHOOL SCHEDULE

6:30-7:15	<u>Welcome & Self selected activities</u> : table games, puzzles, reading center, construction, creative arts, etc.
6:45-8:30	<u>Snack bar</u> open and available.
7:15-8:00	<u>Arts and Crafts</u> : Children have the opportunity to utilize their imaginations to create paintings, murals, long-term craft projects; such as doll houses, model cars, clay dinosaurs, and learn artistic techniques and styles of other cultures.
8:00-8:30	<u>Outside/Gym Games</u> : Large muscle activities such as baseball, soccer, kick ball, team building games, jump rope, relay races, etc.
8:30-8:45	<u>Prepare for a day of learning</u> : final bathroom break and clean up.
8:45	<u>Dismissal</u> : staff escort children to class.

AFTER SCHOOL SCHEDULE

3:45	<u>Jrs/Srs</u>	<u>Arrival</u> : Children are warmly greeted by the staff and place their belongings in their personal tote.
3:50-4:05	<u>Srs</u>	<u>Team Time</u> : The group will meet to discuss upcoming events, assist in planning activities, meet with club representatives on designated days, team building activities, brain teasers or do enrichment activities such as science, art history, math, literature, social studies, and sign language.
3:50-4:20	<u>Jrs</u>	<u>Outside/Gym Games</u> : Large muscle activities such as baseball, soccer, kick ball, team building games, jump rope, relay races, that are age appropriate.
4:05-5:30	<u>Jrs/Srs</u>	<u>Snack bar</u> open and available to all children.
4:05-4:30	<u>Srs</u>	<u>Homework/Quiet Choice Activities</u> : Children can begin their homework or choose to read quietly, use the higher level thinking activity center, creative arts activity center, play a table game and long term craft projects.
4:20 -4:35	<u>Jrs</u>	<u>Team Time</u> : The group will meet to discuss upcoming events, assist in planning activities, meet with club representatives on designated days, team building activities, brain teasers or do enrichment activities such as science, art history, math, literature, social studies, and sign language.
4:30-5:00	<u>Srs</u>	<u>Outside/Gym Games</u> : Large muscle activities such as baseball, soccer, kick ball, team building games, jump rope, relay races, that are age appropriate.

5:30-6:00	<u>Jrs/Srs</u>	<u>Self-Selected Activities</u> : Table games, reading center, construction, creative arts, puzzles, etc. At this time children can take part in the Special Projects Activity center, which focuses on enrichment areas of cooking, drama, math, science, social studies, literature and woodworking.
6:00-6:30	<u>Jrs/Srs</u>	<u>Clean Up</u> : Children and staff at various times are assigned to specific jobs



		and assist in the cleanup of the center.
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PROGRAM ORIENTATION

Parent orientations are held at each center in September/October and again in May for new registrants by the center Director. A tour of the center is given, the daily schedule reviewed and any questions will be addressed. Families enrolling other months of the year may schedule an individual orientation with the Director.

SNACKS

Snack bars are available to the children both in the morning and afternoon programs. A minimum of two food groups are provided for the children along with milk or fruit juice and water each AM and PM session. The snack bars are available to the children for approximately 30 minutes in the morning and an hour and a half in the afternoon. Snack menus are posted on our Parent Bulletin Boards.
